

# Nino Conillo

Wet feet in the rabbits' burrow!  
Exciting dice game for 2 or more  
animal lovers from 3 years.

## Story

It is pouring with rain. The little rabbit Nino Conillo and his friends are getting wet feet. Their underground burrow is gradually filling up with water. The water eventually comes up to their necks so they must run quickly to one of the five exits in order to leave the burrow. Who can help to rescue the most rabbits from danger?

wooden rabbits,  
1 colour dice,

## Preparation

To begin with, place the bottom part of the box in the middle of the table within reach of all players. The box shows the rabbits' burrow with its five coloured exits.

Place all the rabbits in the burrow in the middle of the box.  
Have the colour dice ready.

## Aim of the game

The players try to save as many rabbits as possible from the burrow.

## How to play

The player who has the longest ears begins. You play in a clockwise direction, one after the other. The player whose turn it is throws the dice.

If the dice shows a **colour**, look at the exit with the corresponding colour: If there is no rabbit on the step of the colour shown on the dice, you take a rabbit from the middle and place it on the step.

If there is already a rabbit on the step with the corresponding colour, you can rescue it. Take the rabbit and place it in front of you on the table.

If the dice shows a **rabbit**, you immediately take a rabbit from the middle and place it in front of you.

## End of the game

The game is over when there are no more rabbits in the burrow. The rabbits still standing on the steps are not counted. The player who has rescued the most rabbits wins the game.

## Variants

You may determine that a player can throw the dice once more if he gets a rabbit.

As an alternative, you may also determine that a player has to put one of his rabbits back into the burrow if he throws a rabbit. In this case, the game will last longer.

Now quickly rescue Nino Conillo and his friends!
